LOGLINE

A devoted father overcome with despair over his young son's illness learns that true freedom comes from love and letting go.

SHORT SYNOPSIS

Tim's young son Devon is very ill. To cope with his emotions, Tim takes daily jogs to the boardwalk. It is here that he buys Devon a red balloon every day to encourage him to keep fighting. Devon always begs to join him but Tim refuses, worried about his condition. While reflecting with his wife Milly on days when Devon was still well, their younger daughter hurries in to tell them Devon's acting up. Tim rushes in to discover Devon cutting the balloon strings, wishing to see them fly. Overwhelmed with emotion, Tim ventures out alone immediately for a new balloon, despite Devon's pleas to tag along. But at the boardwalk, the vendor is all out of red balloons, sending Tim into a panic. The Vendor offers some sage advice that helps Tim understand he needs to let Devon keep living his life, despite his diagnosis. Tim collects Devon and brings him to the boardwalk where they are welcomed by the Vendor holding an enormous bunch of red balloons. Later, when Devon wants to let this new balloon fly, Tim can finally release his fear for the future and enjoy this moment with his son by his side. Together on the beach they watch the balloon float up and out of sight.

DIRECTOR'S VISION

The inspiration for this project came to me in October 2018 in Busan, Korea. I was attending the Busan International Film Festival with long time friend and director Justin McConnell as our film LIFECHANGER was part of its Festival program. While we were there, Justin and I witnessed a typhoon. We sat in our hotel room and watched as rain pelted down and high winds caused destruction. As I watched how things can change in an instant it caused me to wonder, if my life ended today, what would be my one career regret? The answer: never directing anything.

After producing over 55 films in a span of 25 years and watching talented Canadian people tell Canadian stories, I decided it was time to make a passionate Canadian story of my own. Over the years I have collaborated with some amazing Canadian directors including Mike McGowan, Gary Burns, Sean Cisterna, Justin McConnell, Sarah Goodman, and Gaurav Seth to name a few. Most recently, I had an opportunity to finally work with my friend and staunch Canadian filmmaker Warren P. Sonoda. The experience of working with Warren and witnessing his fire and passion to tell his Canadian story propelled me to want to tell mine. Warren's THINGS I DO FOR MONEY was his vehicle to do it, and mine is RED BALLOON.

Witnessing the typhoon in Busan pushed me to start searching for my Canadian story, so when I got back from the festival, I posted a note on Facebook that I was looking for a short film script to direct. I received over 100 submissions in just a few days! I read them all, but RED BALLOON was the one that spoke to me most. When I read it, I cried. It reminded me of the films that I like to produce like ONE WEEK, STILL MINE and KISS & CRY. I want to affect people with this film the same way films like LIFE IS BEAUTIFUL have affected me. Through creating this film, I hope to give hope to those who are currently struggling watching a loved one with an illness.

As a father of three daughters, the relationships between the characters in this film speak to me. The goal was to make a film that is emotional and cinematic. But more importantly, I want this story to make people take a second to appreciate people in their lives and hold on tight because life can change in an instant.

Gord is an actor, playwright and filmmaker. He has performed on stages around the world, from San Francisco to Rwanda, including 9 seasons at The Shaw Festival. Most recently, he played the title role in OEDIPUS REX at The Stratford Festival and HAMLET for Necessary Angel at the Worldstage. He won a Dora Award for his portrayal of a naked Ukranian plutonium dealer in Michael Healey's THE INNOCENT EYE TEST (Mirvish). He also toured the world with GOODNESS (Volcano Theatre), and appeared in THE TEST (The Company), THE PHILANDERER (Shaw Festival) and ABYSS (Tarragon). He has just completed his next feature film - based on his 2005 hit play POND LIFE and is writing a new play - THE RECLINE OF THE AMERICAN EMPIRE. ADALINE / ORIGINAL SCORE

A successful and prolific composer of music for film and television the Canadian-born now Los Angeles-based artist has had compositions featured in over 80 scenes including GREY'S ANATOMY, 90210, ROOKIE BLUE, LOST GIRL, RINGER, ROYAL PAINS, FLASHPOINT, DEGRASSI, THE LISTENER, HEART-LAND, BOMB GIRLS, KILLJOYS, THE SAMARITAN and more. She worked with Brendan Canning of Broken Social Scene on the score for the Bret Easton Ellis written film, THE CANYONS, directed by Paul Schrader, starring Lindsay Lohan, and on the documentary feature YOUTH UNSTOPPABLE which features music from Radiohead and Moby.

Adaline's sophomore release MODERN ROMANTICS earned a nomination for Pop Recording of the Year at the Western Canadian Music Awards and was deemed by CBC Radio "A visionary classic; A breathtaking in depth journey of the imagination". She was selected to do a 10 month composer residency at Norman Jewison's Canadian Film Centre where she collaborated with Canada's up and coming film talent. She is also the voice behind many commercial campaigns including the Cineplex successful short film LILY AND THE SNOWMAN which features her cover of FOLLOW YOU FOLLOW ME by Genesis. The film went viral online garnering over 55 million views and was seen by 40 million people in theatres.

Adaline's latest release AQUATIC received critical acclaim from Paste Magazine, Highlight Magazine, The Line of Best Fit and Pop Dust saying, "Adaline is pop music's best-kept secret". The music video for the single NOSTALGIA features GREY'S ANATOMY star and fellow CFC alumni Giacomo Gianniotti.

Her upcoming release DEAR ILLUSION is a collection of music inspired by the Californian landscape. Breezy pop hooks infused with stories of disillusionment, addiction, and a journey into a revelatory love. Largely produced by Maximilian Jaeger (Diplo, Big Sean) there is a noted shift from the moody sound we would normally expect from Adaline. Lyrically still dark and reflective but with a sonic lightness that feels dreamy, ethereal and bright - a heavy heart standing in the sun.

Ginger is currently in her 9th season of Costume Designing for the long running comedy series LETTERKENNY (HULU/CraveTv).




